**Agenda Item #1 – Call to Order**

Ms. Dukes called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

**Agenda Item #2 – Introductions/Roll Call**

Ms. Dukes asked those present to state their name and affiliation with the committee.

**Agenda Item #3 – Approval of Regular Meeting Minutes**

The CAC did not have a quorum so the minutes were not approved. Mr. Mike Fletcher made a motion to approve the TAC minutes from September 4, 2024. Mr. Ben O’Dowd seconded the motion. The TAC minutes were approved with unanimous consent. Mr. Scott Matheson made a motion to approve the PC minutes from September 4, 2024. Mr. Bill Slaughter seconded the motion. The PC minutes were approved with unanimous consent.

**Agenda Item #4– New Business - Committee Recommendation/ Approval Required**

**A. Resolution FY25-3 FY2024-2027 TIP and MTP Amendments**

**Action: Approval/Adoption**

Ms. Martin explained the FY2024-27 Transportation Improvement Program and the Vision2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan were being amended to update requirements for amendment and administrative procedures. Mr. Slaughter made a motion to approve the resolution. Mr. Matheson seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous; the resolution was adopted.

**B. 2050 MTP Update**

Mr. Rob Schiffer representing Metro Analytics updated the committee on the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan process. Key milestones include the completion of the existing conditions report, while the future transportation needs are currently being worked on. Additional stakeholder and public participation efforts are also being planned in the upcoming months.

**C. VLMPO Projects Update**

Mr. Dennis Carter from GDOT provided status updates for current transportation projects going under construction and design.

**D. Carbon Reduction Program Funds**

Ms. Martin informed the committee that \$209,635 in carbon reduction program funds are about to lapse and that funding will be distributed if no project is found by April 1, 2025.

**Agenda Item #5 – Staff Update**

**A. GTIB Grant/Loan Program**

Ms. Martin announced that the Georgia Transportation Infrastructure Bank grant/loan program cycle is open and set to close on January 12, 2025. Mr. Joe Longo from FHWA also recommended possible funding opportunities that will be open in 2025 such as PROTECT and RAISE.
