## <u>CRP Item # 6 – TIA Update</u>

Mr. Franks notified the committee that the CSRA region was successful in passing another TIA. He continued that the TIA office has continued moving projects forward during the COVID-19 Pandemic. Mr. Franks reviewed the TIA revenue projections and the actual revenue collected in the Southern GA region. He stated that currently the region is still 14% over the overall projection and he is happy to report that we are in a good position. Mr. Harper asked how is the Southern GA region over their projections, while other regions are under? Mr. Franks responded that there are a few reasons, we have a new economist but also several other expemtions that impacted revenue forecasts became applicable that were not applicable previously and we have learned many lessons from the regions that went through the TIA process prior to the Southern GA region. Mr. Mosely presented project information to the panel. He stated that there are 151 projects, \$408 million budget, 27 projects are currently under construction, 23 are complete, and \$21 million has been expended. He continued stating that six total projects have been let by GDOT since the last meeting, four projects totaling a little more than \$8 million.
